For Great Hills Subdivision in NW Travis County



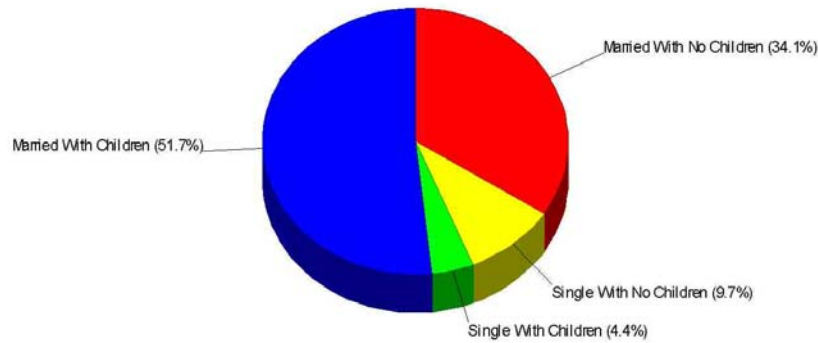
Age Breakdown

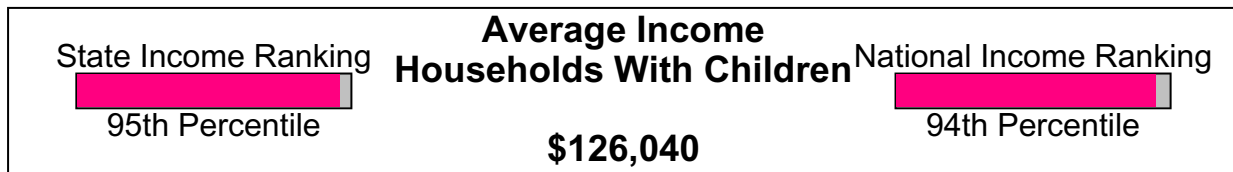
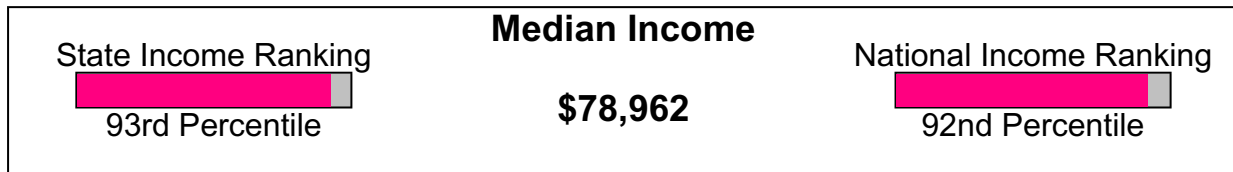


Employment For Great Hills Subdivision in NW Travis County Average Travel Time To Work = 22.1 Minutes



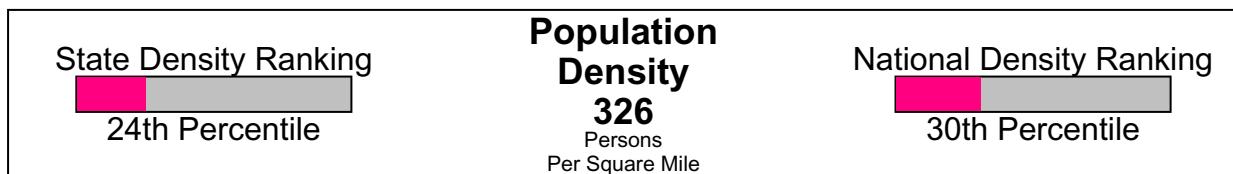

Income For Area of Travis Northwest

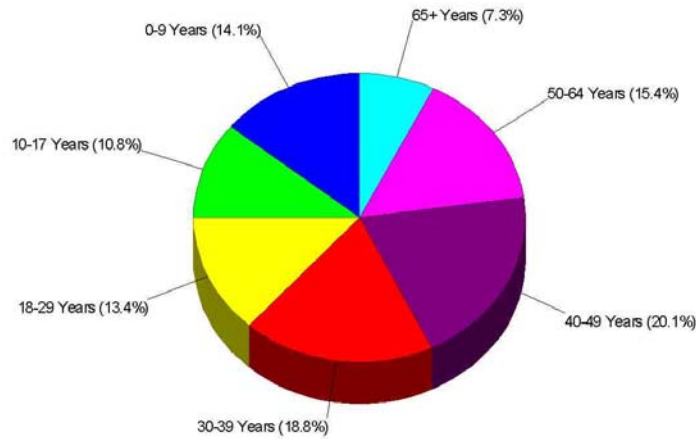

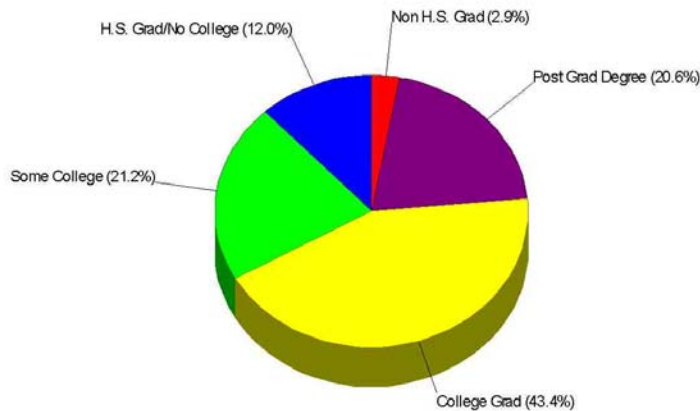

Age Breakdown For Area of Travis Northwest Average Age = 36.5 Years

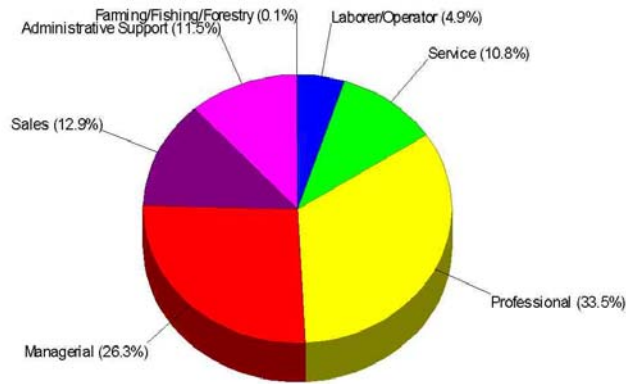

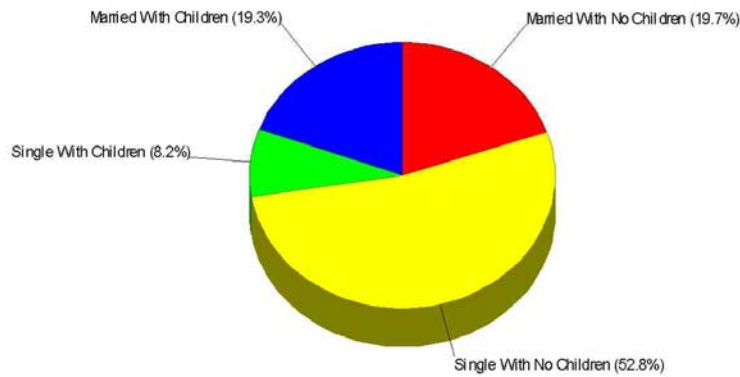
Age Breakdown For City of Austin

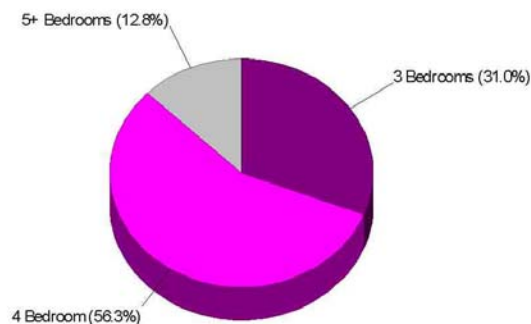

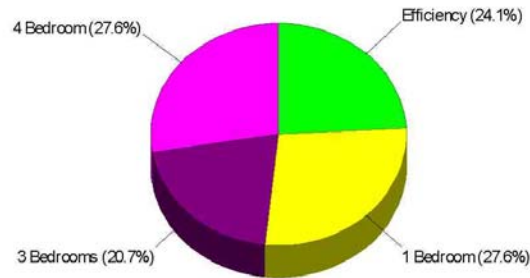

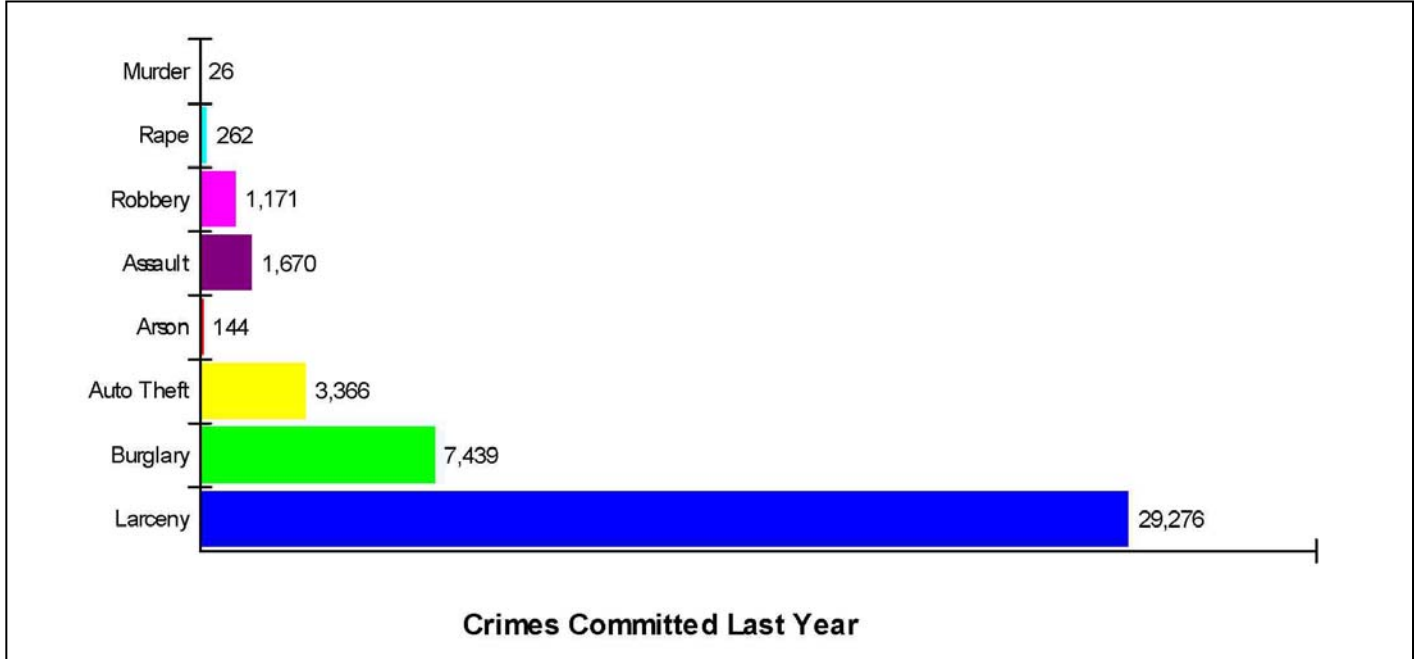

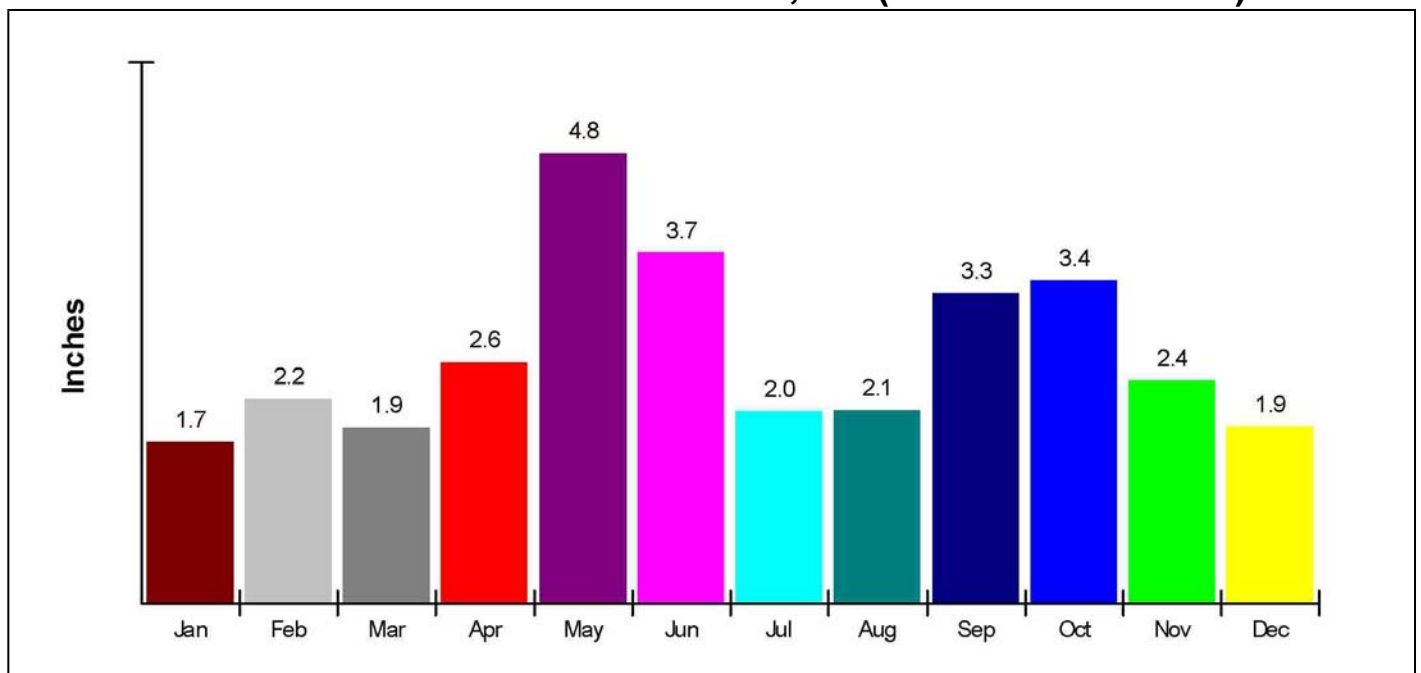
Temperature

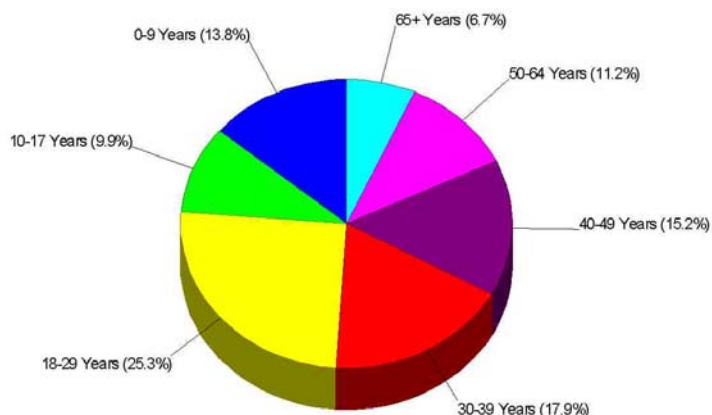

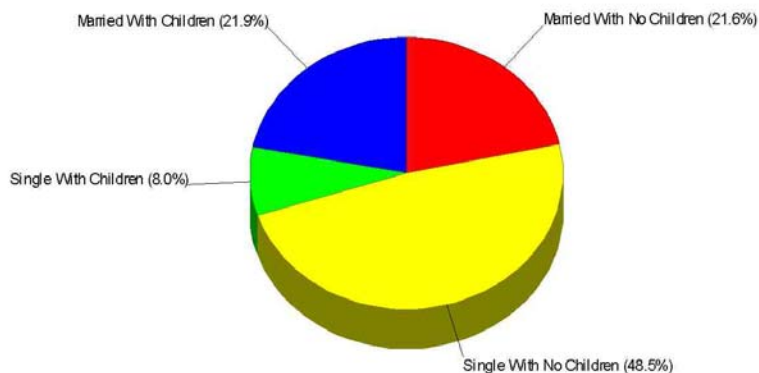


Age Breakdown For Travis County Average Age = 30.5 Years



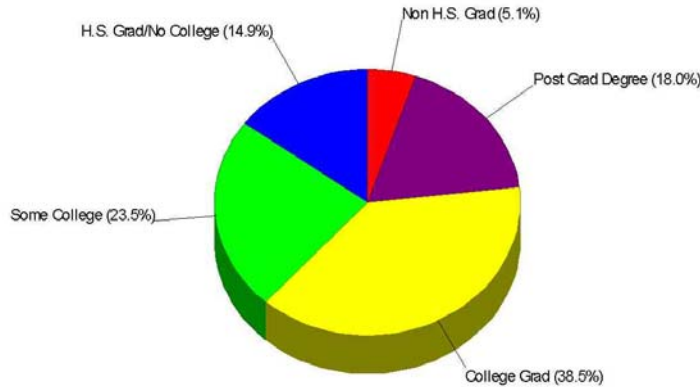
